



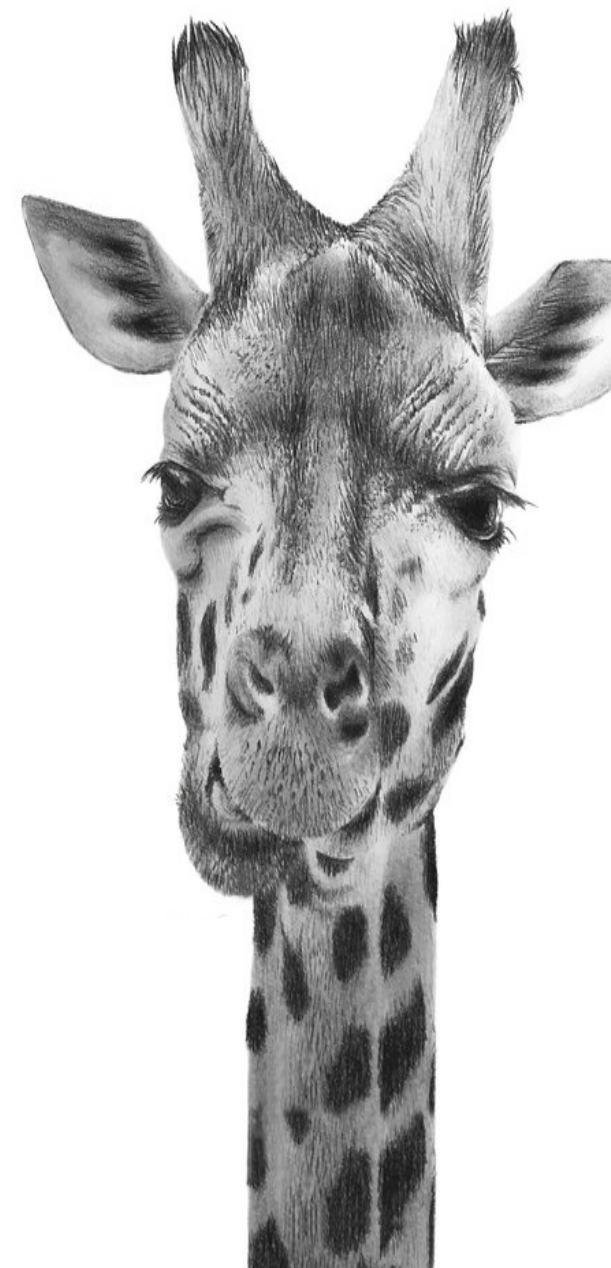

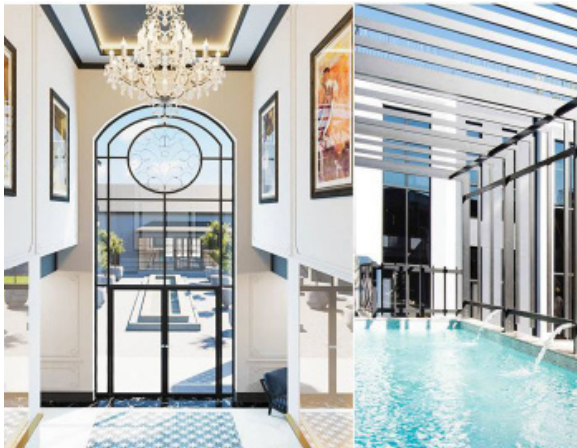

NHOMA SAFARI CAMP

Nhoma Safari Camp is a small activity orientated, tented camp, situated in the north eastern corner of Namibia on state-owned land within the traditional area of the Ju/'hoan San or Bushmen. The ten safari tents of Nhoma Safari Camp overlook the plains from the shade of teak trees. Each built on wooden decks and with a delightfully simplicity and rustic feel made up of a walk-in Meru-style tent, with an en-suite bathroom and private veranda. All the furniture is made by Arno with the help of the community. Nhoma offers something very rare – the time and opportunity to interact with people from a radically different culture; few experiences get you as up close and personal.

An authentic native Namibia experience awaits at Nhoma Safari Camp. You will awake every morning to a view of the Nhoma omuramba, the fossil riverbed. 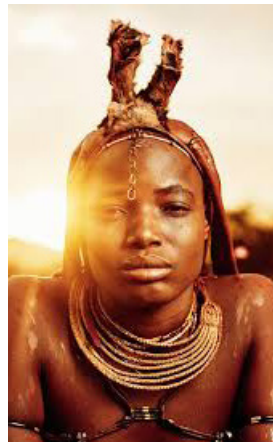
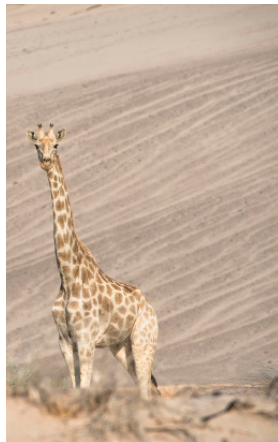
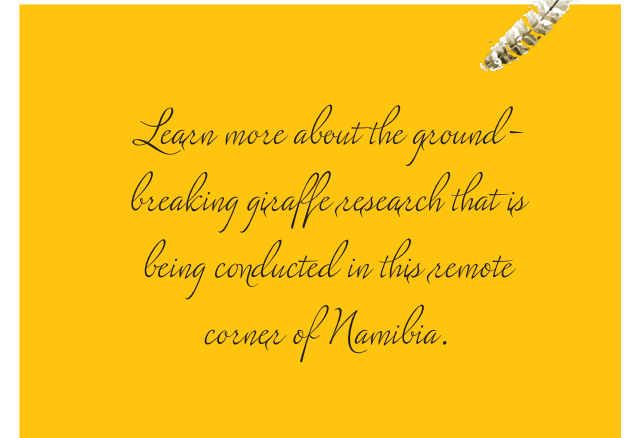

HOANIB VALLEY



In a country jam-packed with vast, spectacularly beautiful landscapes, Kaokoland may just be the most incredible of them all. Deep in north-western Namibia, the area is a melee of towering mountains, sand dunes, and huge expanses of desert, scattered with unique wildlife and nomadic Himba settlements. It's also one of Namibia's most remote and wild environments, and one that not many will get the chance to discover in a lifetime. Hoanib Valley Camp is a joint venture between the local communities and the Giraffe Conservation Foundation, the world's only Africa-wide giraffe conservation organisation, the camp is an elegant, intimate affair that immerses you into the wilds of the desert.



Hoanib Valley's six guest tents blend almost perfectly into the rugged environment. The colours, textures and patterns are inspired by the experience of the Hoanib; the rich ochre of the dunes, the geometric patterns of the Himba people and, of course, the giraffe that inspired the project. The whole camp is a clean and green sort of place, leaving virtually no footprint on this fragile eco-system. It's entirely solar powered to ensure carbon emissions are kept to a minimum, and the tents sit on decks made of a wood, bamboo and 70% recycled-material composite.



Duke's Camp offers eight canvas safari suites, each carefully positioned to offer unforgettable views of the Okavango Delta. The tents are on raised wooden decks and sit elegantly amongst leadwood and ebony trees. Taking their cue from the original Jack's Camp, Duke's Camp revel in the much-loved vintage safari aesthetic of plush fabrics, Persian rugs and hand-carved four-poster beds. It's a seamless blend of yesteryear charm, safari savoir-faire and deep respect for the surrounding natural ecosystems. Duke's Camp offers an unforgettable under-canvas adventure in the midst of this remarkable World Heritage Site.

Duke's Camp is situated in the northern sector of the Okavango Delta, located just north of the iconic Vumbura and Duba Plains, and adjoining the renowned Moremi Game Reserve. The unusually large size of the concession, coupled with a vast abundance of wildlife, ensures a stay at Duke's Camp is a rare opportunity to enjoy a truly wild and untouched corner of the Delta. This is one of the most unique wetland areas in the world, unchanged for centuries, and, regarding by those in the know as one of the best safari destinations there is. Immerse yourself in the wilderness with game drives, mokoro excursions, fishing, and sunset boat trips!



The Tribal Trust Foundation's mission is "supporting the preservation of indigenous cultures and wisdom through philanthropy and education, to promote living in harmony with nature and each other."

The Tribal Trust Foundation responded to the requests for cultural preservation from the Ju/'hoan San community currently living in Nhoma by documenting songs, dances, and traditions and helping to facilitate their ceremonies. The San reported the success of these initiatives in contributing to helping them preserve their culture and rekindle interest among the San youth to learn the ways of their elders, keeping the ancient traditions alive. However, their ancient way of life as hunter-gatherers is at risk of disappearing. They need our support now more than ever.

The Ju/'hoansi San community living in Nhoma, Namibia recognize that it is critical to pass on their traditional knowledge for healing and survival. On the last TTF safari to Namibia, the San requested a school in their remote village so the children could learn from their Elders before it's too late. With the help of a generous donor and the support of our partners in the field, the school building is under construction. The next goal is to raise money to implement the San's pioneering educational model that incorporates an indigenous-led curriculum. The intention is to support nature conservation and cultural preservation while San youth acquire foundational academic concepts in their own language from a teacher that understands and respects their culture.



Barbara Savage has dedicated her time, energy, expertise, and resources to further the mission of the Tribal Trust Foundation. As an educator, Barbara has shared her experiences with students of all ages, including the university level. Her company, Ancestors Film LLC, produces documentary films and exhibitions. Barbara has a twenty five relationship with the San community at Nhoma.
